Ruth's Recipe of the Month

Here's a simple party season appetizer recipe du jour: Bacon Wrapped Enoki with Green Onions, Asparagus and Zucchini: Heat oven to 350 degrees. Lightly grease a cookie sheet. Trim, clean and separate Enoki mushrooms into 6 bunches. Trim and peel the asparagus. Arrange bacon strips on sheet. At a perpendicular angle, arrange the enoki, julienned zucchini sticks, one asparagus spear and some green onion tops. Wrap the bacon to form a bundle. Bake for 7-9 minutes. Remove from oven, drizzle with EVOO and season with kosher salt or grey salt and cracked pepper to taste. Serve with drawn butter or ponzu sauce. Serves 6.
