## in a fame game

THE NAMES of Lennon and McCartney have been paired again in a bizarre reunion. PAUL McCARTNEY's step-sister RUTH, 22, has entered a nationwide talent contest co-sponsored by murdered Beatle JOHN LENNON's son, JULIAN, 18.

Ruth and Julian—shown in our exclusive picture—met during contest rehearsals in London this week.

And memories flooded back for both of them of their childhood days at the height of the Beatles' astonishing success.

Ruth says: "It was the first time I've seen Julian for ten years."

"When John and Paul used to get together, CYNTHIA LENNON would bring Julian over and we'd play."

"When the Beatles split up, Julian and I stopped seeing each other and we eventually lost touch. We had a lot to catch up on when we met, though Julian has grown up very quiet and a bit shy."

Liverpool-born Ruth, whose mother married Paul's father, is dancing in a heat of the contest called *Claim To Fame*, tomorrow.

She says: "I'd like to be a musical country actress like SHIRLEY MACLAINE."

The contest, with six weekly heats at London's Embassy Club, offers the chance for a girl and a girl aged 14 to 18.
